Cookies policy

Our website, like most websites on the Internet, uses connection testimonials, called cookies, to improve and optimize your browsing experience.

Below you will find detailed information about what cookies are, what type of cookies there are, which are used by our website, how you can disable them in your navigation and how you can block the installation of third party cookies.

By pressing "Accept", you consent to the hosting of cookies from our website on your computer or mobile device.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small pieces of text (or connection testimonies) sent to your browser by the websites you visit. They help the website to memorize information about your visit, retaining only information related to your preferences, not including, as such, your personal data. The placement of cookies will help the website to recognize your device the next time the user visits it.

We use the term cookies in this policy to refer to all files that collect information in this way. The cookies used do not collect information that identifies the user. Cookies collect generic information, such as the way users arrive, the language they use and the way they use the websites or the area of the country through which they access the website, etc. Cookies only retain information related to your preferences. At any time, the user can, through his internet browser (browser) decide to be notified about the receipt of cookies, as well as block the respective entry in his system.

Refusing to use cookies on the website, may result in the impossibility of having access to some of its areas or receiving personalized information.

WHAT ARE COOKIES FOR?

Cookies are used to help determine the usefulness, interest and number of uses of your websites, allowing for faster and more efficient navigation, eliminating the need to repeatedly enter the same information.

WHAT KIND OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

We use different types of cookies that have different functions. Let's see:

- a) Strictly necessary (essential) cookies: They allow navigation on the website and the use of its applications, as well as access to secure areas of the website. Without these cookies, the services, which you have requested, cannot be provided. Some cookies are essential to access specific areas of our website.
- b) Analytical cookies: These cookies are used to analyze how users use the website and monitor its performance. This allows us to provide a high quality experience by personalizing our offer and quickly identifying and correcting any problems that arise. For example, we use performance cookies to find out which pages are most popular, which method of linking between pages is most effective, or to determine why some pages are receiving error messages. These cookies are used only for the purpose of statistical creation and analysis, without ever collecting personal information.
- c) Functionality cookies: Keep the user's preferences regarding the use of the website, so that it is not necessary to configure the website again each time you visit it.
- d) Third Party Cookies: Measure the success of applications and the effectiveness of third party advertising. They can also be used to customize a widget with user data.

On the other hand, cookies can be:

- e) Permanent Cookies: They are stored, for a variable time, at the level of the internet browser (browser) on their access devices (pc, mobile and tablet) and are used whenever the user makes a new visit to the website. They are generally used to direct navigation according to the user's interests, allowing us to provide a more personalized service.
- f) Session Cookies: They are temporary, remain in the cookies of your internet browser (browser) until you leave the website. The information obtained allows to identify problems and provide a better browsing experience.

HOW TO DISABLE THE USE OF COOKIES?

If the user so wishes, it is possible to stop accepting cookies from the browser, or to stop accepting cookies from any particular service.

All modern browsers allow you to change your cookie settings. These settings are found in the browser settings.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN COOKIES ARE DISABLED?

Some features and services may be disabled or behave differently than expected, for example, remain identified, keep purchases in the "shopping cart" in the case of an e-commerce service or receive information directed to your location, among other situations.

If you disable the use of cookies on this website, it is likely that you will no longer be able to access certain areas that are normally found in the "Options" or "Preferences" of the browser menu.

The user may, at any time, disable the use of cookies on this website.

Other third-party tools, available online, allow users to detect cookies on each website they visit and manage their deactivation even if the browsing experience on it noticeably degrades.

GLOMARKET may modify this cookie policy according to legal, regulatory or instructions from any European Data Protection Agency, which is why users are advised to review it periodically.
